NOTES AND DEFINITIONS

1. **Europe:** Europe is defined broadly to include both immigrants to Europe and emigrants from Europe to other parts of the world. Emigrants are included only when they are strongly tied to a particular part of Europe rather than including all European derived populations in North America, Latin America and the Pacific. This distinction is, of course, an ambiguous one, but its purpose is to include references of significant interest to Europeanists even when they deal with people no longer living in Europe.
2. **Anthropology:** Anthropology is defined narrowly. Although many works by historians, sociologists, folklorists, and others are of interest to anthropologists, this bibliography is restricted to works by authors with strong claims, based on training or employment, to being anthropologists. Archeology and physical anthropology have also not been included.
3. **Language:** This bibliography is restricted to publications in English. Obviously, a great deal of relevant material in other European languages has therefore been excluded.
4. **Women/Gender:** The topic of "women" has been defined to include images of women and gender concepts as well as discussions of the social and economic position of women. Although a complete gender bibliography should include references dealing only with men as well as those on women or comparing men and women, such references have been included here only when they are explicitly relevant to "women's studies" issues. The major excuse for such a decision is the difficulty of distinguishing between research on men which relates to gender issues and research which is about men simply because the researcher forgot to consider gender at all. The decision about which articles on such general anthropological topics as kinship, demography, production and reproduction should be included in a bibliography about women is also somewhat arbitrary. The present choice has been to use narrower rather than wider criteria for inclusion.

Additions and corrections to the present bibliography are more than welcome. This bibliography has been collected over a period of 15 years and is continually being added to and modified.
